Context:

Under the overall supervision of the Medical Director and the direct supervision of the Nursing Head, the successful candidate will undertake the below mentioned responsibilities supporting the Khair Khwa Medical Complex.

Responsibilities:

- Administer anesthetic or sedation during medical procedures, using local, intravenous, spinal or caudal methods.
- Confer with other medical professionals to determine type and method of anesthetic or sedation to render patient insensible to pain.
- Coordinate administration of anesthetics with surgeons during operation procedures.
- Coordinate with relevant medical staff on transferring patients to rooms/wards or discharged following outpatient surgery once they are recovered or stabilized.
- Examine patients, obtain medical history and use diagnostic tests to determine risk during surgical, obstetrical, and other medical procedures.
- Monitor patients before, during, and after anesthesia and counteract adverse reactions or complications.
- Record type and amount of anesthesia and patient condition throughout procedure.
- Conduct medical research to aid in controlling and curing disease, to investigate new medications, and to develop and tests new medical techniques.
- Coordinate and direct work of nurses, medical technicians and other health care providers.
- Diagnose illnesses, using examinations, tests and reports.

- Inform students and staff on types and methods of anesthesia administration, signs of complications, and emergency methods to counteract reactions.
- Manage anesthesiology services, coordinating them with other medical activities and formulating plans and procedures.
- Order laboratory tests, x-rays and other diagnostic procedures.
